Your selection as a class member in *Experience Your Smokies* requires a commitment to attend all of the program's classes (from July through December). The sessions require all participants to be physically active, including walking across uneven and steep terrain for up to ½ mile, standing for extended periods of time, and participating during moderately inclement weather. It also requires a registration fee of \$175 due upon acceptance. Note: the registration fee does not include a parking pass. Purchase of a parking pass is the responsibility of the applicant.
